The jurisdiction above intends to submit an application for STP grant funding as describe below.

Project Title: Medford High Priority Overlays

Amount to be requested: \$ 400,000

Project Description:

Medford has many arterial and collector streets that are starting to have pavement failure. This project would allow up to four (4) streets to be overlaid to provide for long term operations of these roads without having to reconstruct them. The roads that proposed to be overlaid are as follows:

- **Cedar Links Drive – Rosewood to 100’ east of Wilkshire**
- **Edwards Street – Central Avenue to Riverside Avenue**
- **Roberts Road – Crater Lake Avenue to Springbrook Road**
- **Center Drive – Stewart Avenue to 1,450 feet south of Stewart Avenue**

All roads are at least a minor collector or above and are eligible to be overlaid using STP dollars. The project address high priority roads that if not maintained, will likely be allowed to fail and will require reconstruction. These roads all have high traffic volumes and are critical routes for motorists as well as pedestrians and cyclists.
